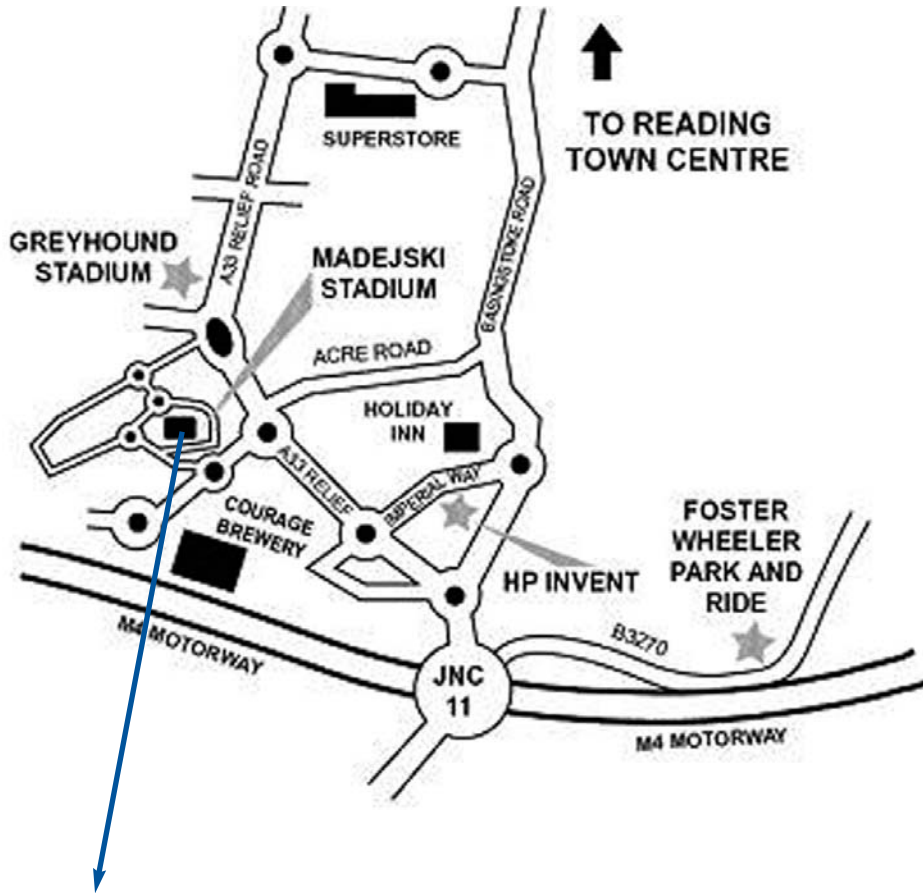

Richard and Tim qualified as radiographers in the early 70s and became lecturers in the early 80's. When the School of Radiography at Keele University closed in 1997 Tim was the Principal for radiography undergraduate studies and Richard was the postgraduate Principal in therapeutic and diagnostic radiography.

They are radiography consultants to the School of Postgraduate Medicine at Keele University and the Faculty of Health at Staffordshire University as well as being Senior Lecturers at the Birmingham University Dental School.

Richard trained as a radiographer in the Royal Navy and his specialist areas are in aspects of care and clinical practice. Tim is an authority on radiation protection and risk management. Both are experienced lecturers in dental radiology and have an extensive portfolio of education and training packages that includes a number of postgraduate update seminars for dentists and the dental team. They have been organising courses for nurses and hygienists since 1991 and each year they deliver over ten dental radiography courses for nurses throughout the U.K.

Mr Wallace Mair was born in 1949 as part of the post-war baby bulge. He studied Latin and Greek gaining an MA at Glasgow University in 1969, followed much later by a Master of Business Administration from Edinburgh University.

For most of his career he was Chief Executive of the Faculty of Actuaries in Scotland where he was exposed to actuarial matters, company law and pensions and insurance issues. Having taken early retirement because of ill-health, he joined the BDA four years ago as its sole consultant on pension and insurance issues covering the whole of the UK.

Dr Caroline Pankhurst BSc, PhD, BDS, MSc, MRCPATH (Specialist in Oral Microbiology) is a dentist and was a Clinical Senior Lecturer, Oral Microbiology, King's College London Dental Institute. Now she is actively involved in postgraduate dental education and training.

She is a freelance infection control consultant to Southwark, Lambeth and Lewisham PCTs and Southern Health Board, Northern Ireland. She is a member of Decontamination in Primary Care committee at the Department of Health.

Her research interests span the following fields: microbial and occupational risks from contaminated dental unit waterlines, dental cross-infection control, management of burning mouth syndrome and xerostomia and musculo-skeletal & occupational health risks to dentists. Currently she is appointed to Editorial Boards of "Primary Dental Care" and BMC Oral Health. She was President of BDA Metropolitan Branch in 2006.
